GLANMIRE ATM ISSUES BLAST FROM THE PAST

An ATM in Glanmire's Hazelwood Centre, has last month issued an old five pound note as a customer was making a withdrawal.

The customer in question, Gráinne Moir, was shocked to say the least, "I was shocked to say the least", she remarked. "I almost didn't notice at first, I was getting €40 out, and the fiver was underneath two twenty Euro notes".

So how did this happen? Why did an ATM at the Glanmire Bank of Ireland branch suddenly dispense some defunct tender? A spokesperson for Bank of Ireland explained, "whilst it is unusual, it's not unheard of, some of the older ATM models have rogue notes that have slipped between the mechanism. (CONCUSSION)

A concussion is a mild traumatic brain injury (TBI). It can occur after an impact to your head from a hard or blunt object, e.g a tape measure thrown from close range. Concussions can also occur after a whiplash-type injury that causes your head and brain to shake quickly back and forth. A concussion results in an altered mental state that may include becoming unconscious.

This is not to be confused with your subconscious. In fact confusing these terms, or casually using the phrase "*he was knocked subconscious*" is a sign that someone has recently suffered a concussion. I would advise in this instance to phone your local GP for an appointment. Other symptoms include memory problems, super confusion, headaches, dizziness, slow reactions to stimuli and slow to change channels on the television.

However it is not always necessary to seek medical attention should you spot one or more of these symptoms. On occasion, a concentrated and stern shout at the person suffering symptoms can jolt them back to normal. The shouting should be general, not too insulting and should last no longer than one minute. It's not a treatment that you will find in most medical textbooks, but it's a simple treatment that is almost certainly worth a shot before calling 999.

If you have suffered a concussion and this is causing further headaches, your doctor may recommend over-the-counter pain relievers such as paracetamol or ibuprofen. Your doctor will also probably advise you to get plenty of rest (*they always throw this one at you, thanks Doc, here's your €60*). They may also advise to avoid sports and other strenuous activities and avoid driving a vehicle or riding a bike or horse for a few days, depending on the severity of your injury.

Whilst not normally mentioned, this list of activities includes sex. Sex with another person or persons should be avoided for a short period of time. This is not so much because it is strenuous, but rather because it is a sensory overload for the brain when it is in a period of recovery. Intense sexual intercourse with a concussion can cause the patient to experience extreme elation, but also severe spasming, lock-jaw and bowel evacuation.

Avoiding alcohol is also recommended, but the one or two are usually fine.

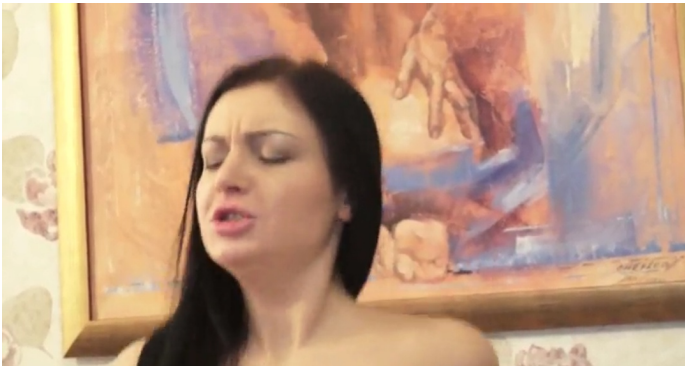

With schools re-opening, Jack and his classmates at New Inn Primary school are very much looking forward to learning about top heavy fractions.



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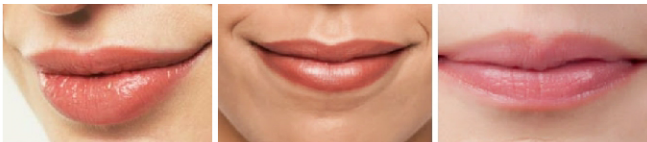

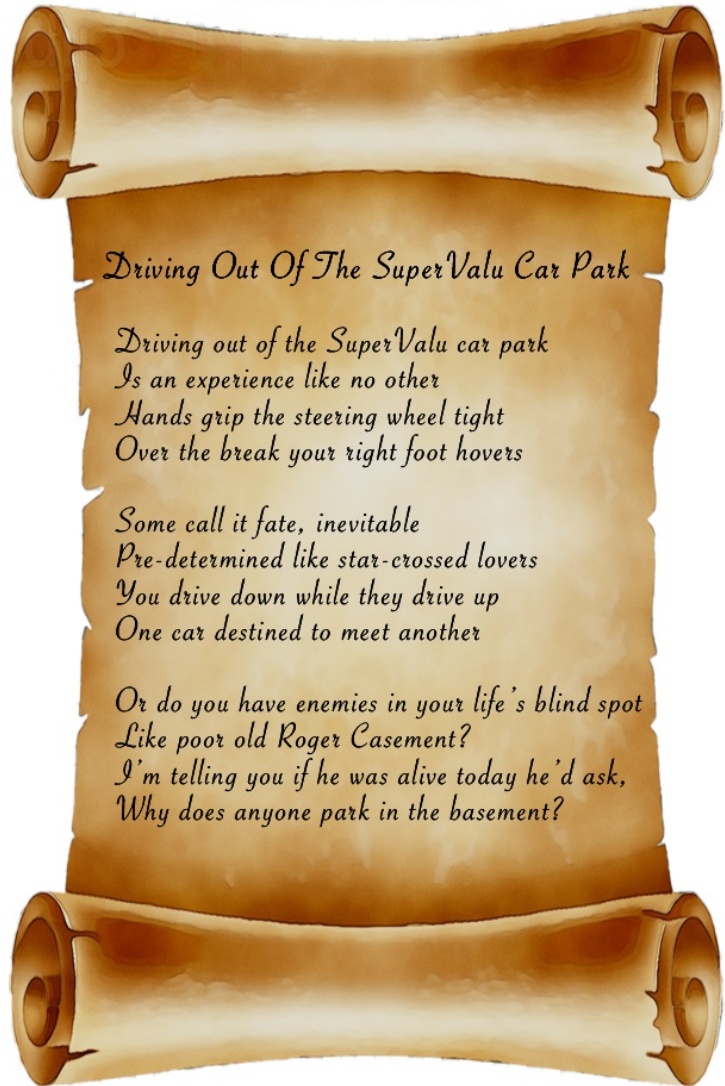

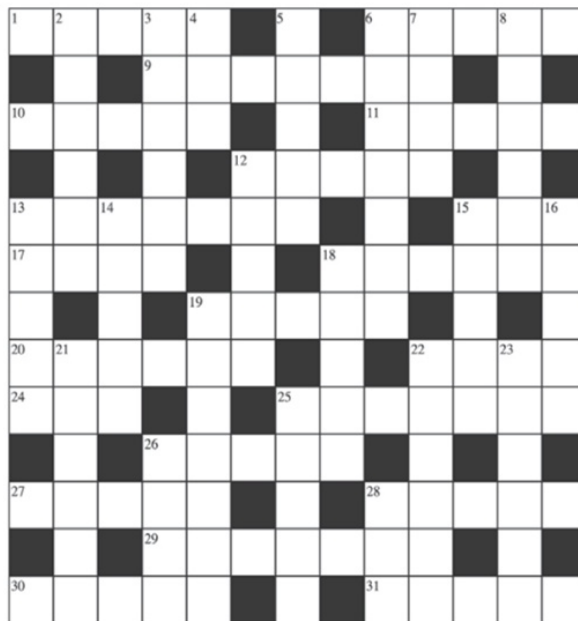
